Remember that your local police and sheriff's departments exist to help you. You should always have their numbers handy for an emergency situation.

IF YOU BECOME A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Call the police or sheriff. If law enforcement is already involved write down the report number.

Make sure you are safe from another beating. Whenever you believe you are in danger, leave your home and take your children with you. Also, take important papers such as your birth certificate, social security cards, ID, vehicle registration, etc.

Get medical attention. Don't try to treat yourself, you may be injured much more seriously than you realize.

Seek assistance. Contact us right away. We are here to help you and your children to find your way in a new healthier way of life.
